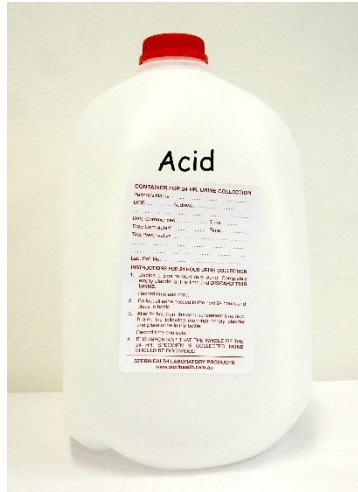


24 HOUR URINE COLLECTION USING AN ACID BOTTLE PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS

Equipment



- Collection bottle, provided (pictured)
- Clean container to collect urine to be tipped into collection bottle. Use a clean separate container.



Safety Precautions

- Keep out of the reach of children
- This bottle contains acid, which is required for the test processing. Therefore, care must be taken when taking the lid off the bottle, not to spill any of its contents.
- Ensure that no body parts are put into the bottle. Pass urine into a separate container and then tip the urine into the acid bottle.
- Store the bottle in a cool, dry, safe place during the collection period.



Instructions

1. Clearly write your Name, Date of Birth and address in the space provided on the label
2. Empty bladder into toilet and record time and date in space provided on the bottle.
3. Collect ALL urine after this specimen, including, during the day, overnight and up until the same time on the following day (i.e. for next 24/12 hours).
4. Replace the lid each time you add urine to the bottle ensuring it is screwed on firmly.
5. Each time a specimen is added to the bottle gently shake the bottle to mix the urine with the acid.
6. At the end of collection period, empty your bladder into bottle and record time and date in space provided on the bottle.
7. Bring bottle and request form into the Pathology Collection rooms, as soon as possible after completion of the 24 hour period.
